
How To Enable SMTP Authentication on Windows Guide



Windows Mail

- Click the **Tools** menu.
- Click Accounts.
- Select your email account, and then click **Properties.**
- Click the **Servers** tab.
- Under **Incoming Mail Server** in the field labeled **Email Username** enter your full email address.
- Put a check next to "My server requires authentication"
- Click the **Settings** button.
- Select the option next to "Use same settings as my incoming mail server"






Note: Outgoing Mail Server window becomes active once selecting the **Settings** button.

Outlook Express (Windows 95/98/ME/2000/XP) & Outlook 2000+

- Click the **Tools** menu.
- Click Accounts
- Select your email account, and then click **Properties.**
- Click the Servers tab.
- Under **Incoming Mail Server** in the field labeled **Account Name** enter your full email address.
- Put a check next to "My server requires authentication"
- Click the **Settings** button.
- Select the option next to "Use same settings as my incoming mail server"

Mozilla Thunderbird

- Click the email address in the panel on the left.
- •Click " View settings for this account."
- •Click **Outgoing Server (SMTP)** in the panel on the left.
- Select your United Communication's email account.

- •Click Edit.
- Change Authenication method to Password, transmitted insecurely
- •In the field labeled **User Name** enter your full email (See Below)
