Amazon Fire TV Stick 4K

Much less expensive but still just as great is the Amazon Fire TV Stick.

It has less robust Alexa capabilities and no storage, but you'll have access to all the HDR/4K streaming functionality of the cube in a smaller, more affordable package.

Roku® Streaming Stick® +

Roku® Streaming Stick® + is like Roku, but designed better and supports HDR and 4K.

This set hooks into your TV via a separate but included HDMI cable. You'll then have access to Netflix, Hulu, Amazon Prime and more.

Best for: Fans of Google products, hands-free

Google Chromecast Ultra

Google's streaming plugs directly into your TV with no hassle.

Supporting HDR and 4K, you can access popular streaming services and Google's Play Store, which has many more apps and services to choose from.

Apple TV® 4K

Apple's popular Apple TV product now supports 4K and HDR. Plus, it also supports Dolby Atmos for a truly stellar sound experience.


